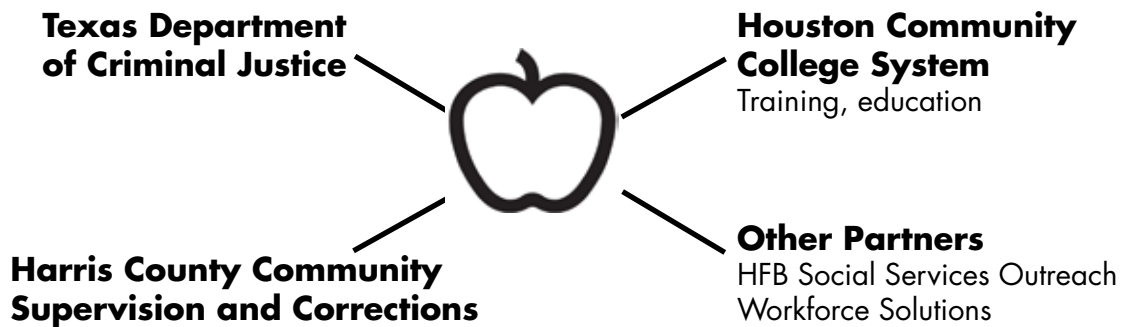


Serving for Success
